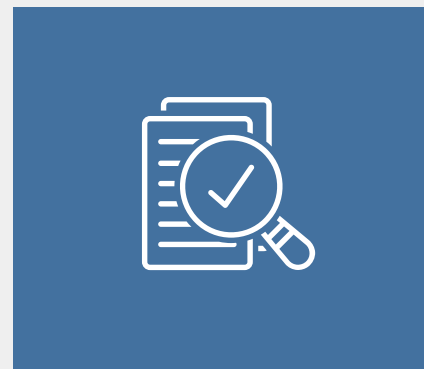
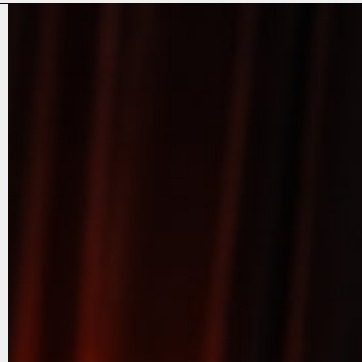

Philanthropy Tech Summits

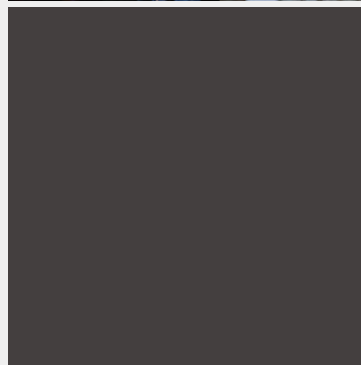
